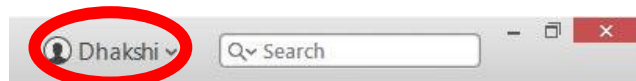

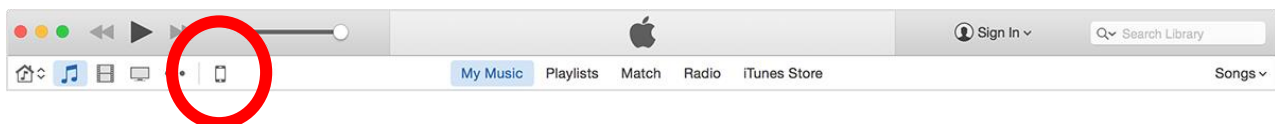
iTunes on Windows Computer Part II

Want to sync photos from your iPhone to your computer? You can easily do so by following these simple steps.

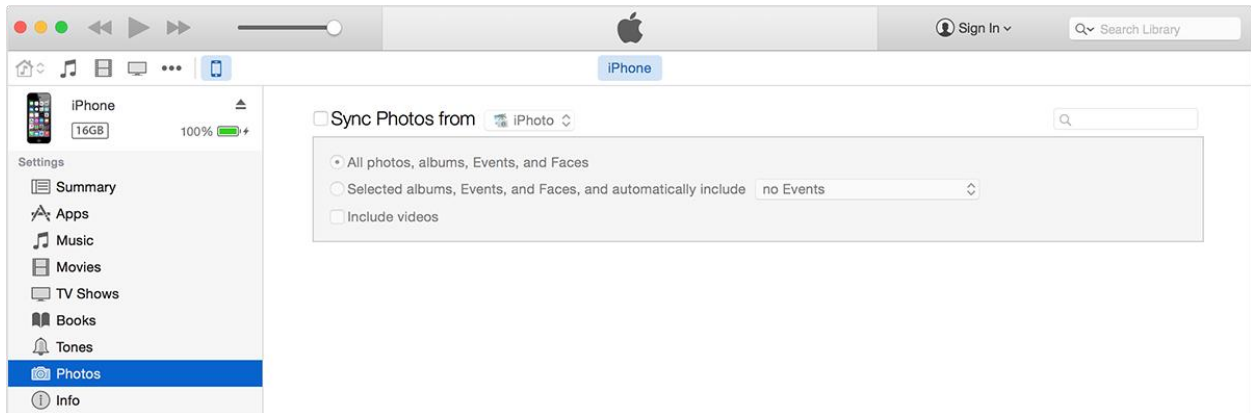
1. Locate iTunes. The easiest way to do this would be to perform a search through your programs. Move your cursor to the bottom left of the screen and click on the “Search” option. The placement may vary depending on your operating system.
2. Sign in with your Apple ID to get the most from your iTunes with customizations. Find the sign in option on the upper right side of the screen.



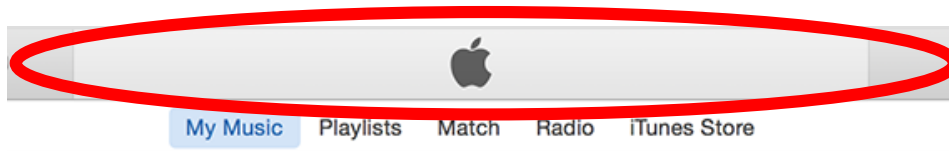
3. Connect your iOS device to your computer by using a USB cable that connects the cord from the phone port to the USB 2.0 port.
4. Select the device located on the right side of the top left bar.



5. Select “Photos” on the left sidebar. Click “Sync Photos from” in order to download the photos from your phone onto your computer.



6. This procedure can be repeated for any tab located on this left bar such as Apps, Music, Movies, TV Shows, Books, etc.
7. Now, to actually sync all your checked boxes, select “Apply” to apply changes in regards to which information to sync. Then, click the “Sync” button located in the lower right corner of the screen. All the information that you checked off will be synced to your computer and vice versa. Progress can be seen on the top of the screen.
